





The green in between Baltimore and Washington, D.C. Patapsco Valley State Park

eople say that a picture is worth a thousand words. Images can inspire us to travel to faraway and nearby places, for the day or even a weekend. So pack your camera to explore the 100-plus miles of stroller- and wheelchair-friendly paved trails in Howard County. Our scenic trails are just right for hiking or biking along lovely lakes, over iconic bridges and past historic places. Especially beautiful at sunrise and at sunset, these outdoor spaces provide perfect opportunities to capture your own images of wildflowers, waterfalls and even wildlife.

Rail-Trail's Historic Bridges

Lovely fall foliage awaits along this 20-mile rail-trail that follows a former Baltimore & Ohio Railroad line along the Patuxent River. Beginning at Savage Park, the rail trail, under a canopy of red maple leaves, crosses 10 bridges including the Guilford Pratt Truss Bridge and ends at Lake Elkhorn in Columbia, a great spot for picnicking. Don't miss the 1869 wrought and cast iron Bollman Truss Railroad Bridge at Historic Savage Mill, the last remaining example of the Baltimore engineering design used all over the U.S. and Europe.

Brighton Dam Azalea Garden at Triadelphia Reservoir


An 800-acre lake, perfect for hiking, picnicking, fishing and boating, is located on the Patuxent River, in both Howard and Montgomery counties, near the town of Brookeville. The reservoir is home to a stunning five-acre woodland garden with more than 20,000 azaleas that bloom each May, delighting visitors.


Daffodil Days at Whipps Cemetery Gardens

One of Ellicott Mills' earliest cemeteries, circa 1855, has been restored and is full of local history and native plants. Local master gardeners have worked hard to create a variety of beautiful settings interspersed with pathways and benches. Whipps Cemetery and nearby Old Ellicott City are especially beautiful in early spring when thousands of varieties of daffodils bloom throughout the gardens.

Blossoms of Hope's 1,700 Cherry Trees

Catch a spectacular display of pink each April, when more than 1,700 Kwanzan cherry trees blossom throughout Howard County. Take a camera and picnic basket and visit 19 different groves of Blossoms of Hope cherry trees at county libraries, local parks, golf courses, historic sites and other attractions. *blossomsofhope.com*

Centennial Lake

The 337-acre park features a spectacular 54-acre, man-made lake stocked by the State Department of Fisheries. The park is home to a variety of wildlife such as white-tailed deer, beavers, foxes, turtles, herons and other birds. You can walk, run or bike the 2.6-mile paved pathway that meanders around the lake, or stay in one spot to cast for bass, trout, sunfish and tiger muskies. From late spring through early fall, boats are available for rent at the General Store/Boat Rental Office located in the park's south area.

Lake Elkhorn

This 37-acre lake in the village of Owen Brown was built by the Columbia Association in 1974 with a watershed of about 2,500 acres. The lake, surrounded by a two-mile path, is stocked with trout each spring. A convenient boat dock allows for quiet relaxation, and Lake Elkhorn's surrounding 23-acre park features a picnic pavilion.




Lake Kittamagundi

This 27-acre man-made lake in Columbia Town Center takes its name from the first recorded Native American settlement in Howard County and means "meeting place." With a maximum depth of seven feet, the lake features a boathouse with a wooden pier and a launching ramp along its western shore. The lake's Nomanizan Island, a popular gathering spot for many summer festivals including the Fourth of July fireworks, can be reached by boat. At the Kennedy Gardens, enjoy the Blossoms of Hope cherry tree grove dedicated to Maggie Brown, which includes three saplings from Washington, D.C.'s famous Tidal Basin trees.

Wilde Lake

This 22-acre man-made lake was built by the Columbia Association in 1967. The site was originally a low-lying meadow of rough grass featuring a small stream. The lake depth ranges from 13 feet at the back of the dam to nearly 8 feet in the lake's center. The dam stands 15 feet high and 200 feet wide with the dam face, constructed of four poured concrete steps, embedded with logs to achieve a cascading waterfall. Wilde Lake, surrounded by a 1.46-mile path, flows downstream into Lake Kittamaqundi.

Merriweather Post mingles music and art

hen Seth Hurwitz became operator of Merriweather Post Pavilion in 2004, his primary goal was to bring the best in musical entertainment to the muchloved amphitheater. But he also envisioned the property as the perfect spot for a sculpture park. Hurwitz, chairman of Bethesda-based concert promoter I.M.P., liked the idea of mingling music and art, which 10 years later is – coincidentally (or perhaps due to Hurwitz's clairvoyance) – a cornerstone of the redesign of Symphony Woods. In the intervening decade, Hurwitz has added an impressive art collection for visitors' enjoyment.

One of the more prominent artists with work on display is Washington, D.C.-based Robert Cole, who died in 2013. Cole, an internationally recognized sculptor, hammered metal into his desired shapes, and then welded the pieces and ground the seams. Although he often started with an organic human form, his figures are often abstract or exaggerated. His 16-foot stainless steel female figure, "Mother of Peace," on the west side of the property, was created for the 2003 International Art Fair in Florence, Italy, and was awarded the Lorenzo de Medici Gold Medal.

MERRIVEATUER

Cole's abstract sculpture "DNA-Tor" was built in Miami, FL for an exhibit at the Macay Museum in Merida, Mexico and is a modern rendition of a Mayan-influenced serpent. His large male figure, "Potension," formerly located on the south side of Merriweather, showed the potential of movement and the tension that exits just before movement occurs. Merriweather was fortunate to be home to these displays for a few years, and now they are showcased at other locations.

Another popular sculpture was the award-winning "Great Key West Chicken," a 7,500-pound, 15foot bird constructed from old farm equipment. Designed by Maryland artist Derek Arnold, the bird is fitted with a dashboard, a seat, and hydraulic controls to move left and right. Even the beak opens and closes. This unique sculpture was so popular it was purchased to reside at a private home in Martha's Vineyard. In place of the Chicken, Arnold's bird "High on a Perch" overlooks the Merriweather property.

The most colorful work of art is Chas Colbourn's

"Viewfinder," made of painted blue steel. It provides the perfect frame for viewing the Merriweather property from any angle.

The grounds boast a backyard lounge with a "trailer park chic" look. While sipping a cool beverage, concert-goers can contemplate the surrounding artwork, including a mysteriously entwined pickup truck in a tree, or the genuine Airstream mobile home that doubles as a bar.

Also scattered throughout the property are hand-carved benches and other eye-catching pieces made from natural materials to blend into the rustic surroundings of the venue.

So next time you come to a Merriweather show, instead of going directly to your seat, take a stroll around the property and enjoy the thought-provoking multimedia sculptures. The outdoor sculptures create a perfect complement to the Merriweather music, allowing visitors to escape into a world of art and creativity. 





James Rouse & Columbia

James Rouse changed the face and focus of Howard County in the 1960s with his vision and execution of the renowned planned city of Columbia. Howard County was catapulted into the burgeoning Baltimore-Washington corridor as Columbia, and eventually its surrounding areas, became a highly desirable place to live, work and play.

James Rouse (circa 1969) Columbia was just one piece of the portfolio that earned Rouse recognition and praise while cementing his place in the history of the built environment

of the United States. He was a pioneer in the development of shopping centers. The Rouse Company developed the first enclosed mall on the East Coast, opening Harundale Mall in Baltimore in 1958. And it was Rouse who developed the concept of festival marketplaces, including Faneuil Hall in Boston, Harborplace in Baltimore and South Street Seaport in New York City. His contributions to revitalizing these cities landed him a cover story in *Time Magazine* in 1981.

Jim Rouse helped change the face of cities and suburbs by providing answers to some of the most pressing challenges of the times. The shopping centers, festival marketplaces, the planned community of Columbia, Maryland and affordable housing throughout the country that he envisioned and developed, and the companies he founded, are concrete examples of his lasting influence. But perhaps Rouse's greatest legacy lies in the way he inspired others with his optimism. He believed that "what ought to be can be," and was convinced that the power of private enterprise could be harnessed to accomplish good.

Rouse was a national figure, but in Howard County he was known as Jim. He lived in Columbia in a modest split-level home until his death in 1996. His vision for a well-designed community that meets the needs of its inhabitants is still alive in this flourishing small city.







The Ellicotts

n 1772, brothers John, Andrew and Joseph Ellicott, Quakers from Bucks County, Pennsylvania, chose the picturesque wilderness upstream from Elk Ridge Landing to establish a flour mill. The brothers helped revolutionize farming in the area by persuading farmers to plant wheat instead of tobacco and by introducing lime as a fertilizer to revitalize the depleted soil. Charles Carroll (only Catholic signer of the Declaration of Independence) was one of the first and most influential converts from tobacco to wheat. It was to Carroll's estate that the Ellicott brothers built the first part of a road that later became the National Road, America's first interstate highway.

The Ellicotts made significant contributions to the area and the era. They helped to create Ellicott's Mills, one of the greatest milling and manufacturing towns in the east at that time. They built roads, bridges and a wharf in Baltimore, introduced the wagon brake, championed plaster as a fertilizer, and erected iron works, a furnace, rolling mills, schools, a meeting house, shops and beautiful granite houses.

In 1791, Andrew Ellicott (son of Joseph Ellicott, Sr. the town founder) was commissioned to survey the boundaries for the nation's new capital, Washington, D. C. Benjamin Banneker, an African American scientist and friend of the family, joined him in his work. Banneker maintained notes for Ellicott, made calculations as required and used astronomical instruments to establish base survey points.

HOWARD COUNTY Communities

HOWARD COUNTY has been one of Maryland's fastest-growing regions of late, increasing its population by 34 percent over the past decade. Population is projected to grow by

nearly 10 percent, to 327,635 by 2035, according to the Howard County Department of Planning and Zoning. Currently, the County's citizens are the wealthiest in Maryland and among the most affluent in the nation.

Howard County, with approximately 300,000 residents, is about community. From Columbia, the pioneering community developed by Jim Rouse in the 1960s, to historic townships such as Ellicott City and charming rural areas such as Clarksville, you can find it all in Howard County.

CLARKSVILLE/HIGHLAND

With approximately 17,000 residents, you'll find two distinctly different communities here. Highland's farms and horse pastures lend a rural feel to the region, while Clarksville is the site of River Hill, Columbia's final village center, and is home to a thriving business community of car dealerships, banks and a garden center among other shops, as well as a new fire station. The area is dotted with large homes, but farmers still till many of the fields.

COLUMBIA

Developed in 1967 on 21 square miles of farmland, Columbia has grown to a

town of more than 98,000 residents in 10 villages. Developer Jim Rouse's vision included racial and cultural diversity and environmentally conscious development. His idea of building each neighborhood around a village center imbues Columbia with the atmosphere of a small town. Yet the city has amenities that a small town can't match, such as downtown offices, a major shopping mall, extensive recreational facilities and a large concert venue.

ELKRIDGE

In 1688, Elkridge was a bustling port on the Patapsco River. Today the river is buffered by a state park with miles of hiking and horseback trails. Main Street in Elkridge is lined with row houses and small businesses, and is a peaceful place – in spite of its proximity to Route 1, the nation's first highway. The town of approximately 16,000 residents maintains its charm with its neighborhoods of Victorian homes and strong sense of community.

ELLICOTT CITY

The Ellicotts, three Quaker brothers from Pennsylvania, founded Ellicott City, the seat of the present county government, as a mill town in 1772. Today, Ellicott City's Main Street is host to many shops and restaurants. The shops carry antiques, home furnishings, pottery, books, clothing and so much more. Beyond Ellicott City's historic heart, Route 40 bustles with shopping areas, grocery stores, gas stations and housing. Ellicott City's population is around 66,000.

NORTH LAUREL/MAPLE LAWN

The Patuxent River separates North Laurel in Howard County from the city of Laurel in Prince George's County. This area is home to a thriving Main Street historic district with shops, antiques stores and restaurants. Maple Lawn, with its large areas of open space integrated into the community, also creates the atmosphere of a small town. It's a place where you can find a unique mix of boutiques and high quality restaurants. The result is an enjoyable, practical way of life, where families can live, work, shop, dine and spend quality time together.

SAVAGE

The community of Savage revolved around a textile mill for decades. Now mill homes have been updated and renovated, and the mill has been transformed into a market for antiques and artisans. The residents of Savage – young and old, newcomers and established homeowners – have worked together to revive the area.

WESTERN HOWARD COUNTY

If you want to take a scenic car ride on a sunny day, drive west on Frederick Road and experience the beautiful countryside of Western Howard County. You'll drive by dairy farms, cornfields, and stables of horses - as well as spectacular new homes that command spacious lots. Cooksville, Lisbon, West Friendship, Glenelg and Glenwood are just a few villages that have evolved in the farmland community.

HOWARD COUNTY offers services that support older adults in their efforts to remain healthy, active and independent while enabling them to age in

their communities if that is what they choose. The County's Office on Aging, part of the Department of Citizen Services, plans, advocates, develops and coordinates programs for older adults, their caregivers and family members. The Office on Aging provides program and referral information for older adults and adults with disabilities, along with comprehensive assessments, care management, in-home services, caregiver support, senior centers and therapeutic social day care.

Offerings include a wide variety of programs and services including fitness programs, educational opportunities, art, music, wellness classes and such recreational activities as games, clubs and more.

The Office on Aging operates six Senior Centers throughout the county, with a range of offerings, such as nutrition, therapeutic programs for those who have additional support needs and a club for those recently diagnosed with dementia. All centers provide a midday meal for individuals 60 and over. Membership is free, but registration is required.

- Howard County Courthouse (1843). Atop Capitoline Hill; sometimes referred to as "Mount Misery." 8360 Court Avenue.

Howard County Historical Society Museum (1894).

Formerly First Presbyterian Church. Now home to hundreds of objects that tell the story of Howard County's history from before European settlement to recent events. Open Friday and Saturday. 8328 Court Avenue.

- 12 The Weir Building (c. 1812). Referred to by Quakers as the "Second School Building" beginning in 1820. Also the former home of Howard County Historical Society Library. 8324 Court Avenue.
- (3) Old Court House (early 1800s).

Originally a private residence and served as a courthouse for the Howard District of Anne Arundel County. Currently houses a timeline exhibit on the history of Elicott City. Behind #14. Open Daily. 8398 Main Street.

14 Thomas Isaac Log Cabin (1780).

Oldest surviving residential structure in Ellicott City. Reconstructed on this site and currently a living-history site featuring colonial life in Ellicott City on the National Road. Open Saturdays and Sundays April–November and special occasions. 8398 Main Street.

(5) Ellicott City Colored School Restored (1880).

A one-room schoolhouse constructed in 1880 as the first public school for black children in Howard County, the building served as a school until the early 1950s. Now houses a genealogical resource center and a museum chroniciling the history of African Americans in Howard County. Open Saturdays and Sundays April–November and special occasions. 8683 Frederick Road. Union Hotel (earliest portion 1820s).
 Was operated by Mrs. Deborah

- Tonge Row (early 1840s). Owned by widow Ann Tonge as rental property, now occupied by specialty shops. 3722-3744 Old Columbia Pike.
- (i) Ellicott Cemetery (1795). Established by the Ellicott brothers 23 years after they founded the town of Ellicott Mills. Adjacent to #19.
- (9) Quaker Meeting House (1799). Built by Elkridge Preparatory Quaker Meeting; converted to a private residence. 3771 Old Columbia Pike.
- The Howard House (1850). Once a busy Main Street hotel, this building now houses apartments and shops, 8202 Main Street.
- Walker Chandler House (1890). Early American structure now filled with art, gifts and antigues. 8180 Main Street.
- Early Stone Tavern (1771). Once a holding site for Civil War prisoners, later enlarged and called "The New Town Hall," now used for a business. 8044-8046 Main Street.
- Former Patapsco Hotel (rebuilt in 1925). Original second floor served as a passenger waiting room in the early days of the B&O Railroad. 8004-8026 Main Street.

B&O Railroad Museum (1831).

The oldest railroad station in America. Currently a living history museum featuring 19th-century interpretive programs. Open Wednesday through Sunday. 2711 Maryland Avenue.

St. Paul's Catholic Church (1830s). Site of Babe Ruth's first wedding. 3755 St. Paul Street.


- Old Patapsco Bank (1840). In 1920, it became a parochial school for St. Paul's Catholic Church. 3755 St. Paul Street.
- Site of the Ellicott Brothers' First Mill (1774). The Ellicotts milled commercial flour at this location. 27 Frederick Road.
- Residence of George Ellicott (1789).
 Relocated and restored.
 24 Frederick Road.
- The Bridge Market (c. 1790). Built by the Ellicotts, it later became Radcliffe's Emporium and coal yard. Used as offices today. 8000 Main Street.
- Banneker Historical Park A national landmark site that was the farmstead of the original Banneker family. The 142-acre park is dedicated to preserving the legacy of Benjamin Banneker. 300 Oella Avenue.

() Carroll Baldwin Hall Built in 1921 in memory

of Carrol Baldwin (President of the Savage Manufacturing Company from 1905-1918) as a community hall for the residents of Savage.

Savage Mill United Methodist Church Built by William Henry Baldwin in 1888.

3 Baltimore Street Townhouses Townhomes built during the Civil War by mill owners to house workers; up to four families shared each space.

Savage Mill "Manor" House

The Savage Mill Manor was built in 1894 as a residence for the superintendent of the Savage Manufacturing Company (the Mill).

(5) Masonic Hall The first school in Savage was operated in what is today Masonic Hall, a community hall for the residents of Savage.

6 Baldwin "Summer" Home The Washington Street

home was built between 1859-1878 by the Baldwin Family (owners of Savage Mill from 1859-1948) as a summer home.

Historic Savage Mill Historic Savage Mill, a working textile mill from 1822 to 1947, was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1974. It is now home to many unique artist studios, home furnishing, antiques and specialty shops.

8 Savage Mill Powerhouse (ruins) The Savage Mill Powerhouse (ruins) produced power for the Mill until Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (BGE) lines were introduced in 1931.

9 Bollman Iron Truss Bridge

The Bollman Iron Truss Semi-Suspension Bridge that spans the Little Patuxent River at Historic Savage Mill is the last standing Bollman Bridge in the world, and is recognized as a National Historic Landmark.

Savage Mill Trail – Foundry Street

Purchased by Howard County in 1978, this trail was formerly part of the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad's rail corridor through central Maryland, built in 1887.
